CARB Tier 2 Portable Equipment 2022 Deadlines for Small Fleets

As a refresher, what is PERP (Portable Equipment Registration Program)? It is a voluntary California Air Resources Board (CARB) program that allows Owners or Operators of portable engines and other types of equipment to register their units under a single entity in order to operate their equipment throughout California without having to obtain individual permits from local air districts.

CALIFORNIA

Common PERP equipment examples: air compressors, generators, concrete/grout pumps, water pumps, and stone drills.

Small Fleets have a total cumulative horsepower of 750 brake horsepower (bhp) or less for all portable engines under common ownership and control of the fleet.

The following deadlines apply to Tier 2 engines built prior to January 1, 2009 with between 50 - 750 bhp.

July 1, 2022

- Last day to designate Tier 2 engines as low-use or emergency use in the PERP program.
- Last day to apply for Tier 2 engines ownership transfer.
- Applications must be postmarked no later than July 1, 2022.

December 31, 2022

 Last day to operate Tier 2 engines under a PERP registration -- absent CARB approved exceptions like low or emergency use.
