### **Live Fire Wall Resiliency Demonstration is in the Books**

On October 27, 2022 we set out to see how two different wall assemblies would react to fire. Wall 1 was a grouted masonry wall. Wall 2 was a fire rated gypsum wall. Propane torches were placed 6" from each wall. Two torches were put on the masonry wall: one torch was

aimed at the clay material and the other focused on the concrete material. One torch was centered on the gypsum wall. Both walls were under flame for 1 hour.

We hired a film crew to capture the experiment with the footage to be part of a video that will be used to represent masonry at the first-ever <u>UC Davis Wildfire Resilient Structures</u> (WiReS) Conference February 2023.

While the pictures above tell the story about how our experiment played out, they do not show the herculean effort that happened behind the scenes.

The CMU Checkoff was approved in a national vote of producers on December 22, 2021. One of the first responsibilities of the board will be establishing a start date for checkoff collections – a penny for every concrete block sold in the U.S. Checkoff leaders estimate more than \$100 million will be invested into promoting the block industry in the first decade of the checkoff. One of the initial tasks of the new board will be determining an assessment timeline and protocol.
