## **Update Your Covid Prevention Plan (CPP)** for Free



On December 15, 2022, the California Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board voted to adopt non-emergency COVID-19 prevention regulations. These regulations took effect on February 3, 2023 and will remain in effect for two years after the effective date (until February 3, 2025), except for the recordkeeping subsections that will remain in effect for three years.

Cal/OSHA and State Fund offer free COVID Prevention Plan (CPP) fillable templates which have been updated as of February 2023 and reflect the December 2022 changes to the COVID non-emergency regulations. The emergency regulations expired February 2023 and have been replaced by the non-emergency standards.
