MCAC - MITA - BAC's 3 & 4 Join Forces to Get California Apprentices to 2026 National Skills Challenge Contest in Las Vegas

California's finest masonry apprentices are heading to Las Vegas in January to compete on the national stage after strong showings at two regional qualifying events held in Southern and Northern California.

On **October 25, 2025**, twenty apprentices competed at the new **Angelus Block facility in Rialto, CA**, in a Southern California regional Masonry Skills Challenge. Earlier in the year, on **April 6, 2025**, apprentices from across Northern California gathered in **Tracy, CA**, for the **BAC Local 3 Masonry Skills Contest**. The first-place winners from each region and skill level—first, second, and third year—earned the honor of representing California at the national competition.

The [2026 MCAA Masonry Skills Challenge](#) will take place at the **World of Concrete** in Las Vegas on **January 21, 2026**, where top apprentices from across the U.S. and select international competitions will face off. Competitors will build their assigned projects—sight unseen—without help from instructors, employers, or anyone else. With only three hours on the clock and materials supplied on site, the event tests precision, speed, and craftsmanship under pressure. Awards will be presented to the top three apprentices in each skill level.

On October 10th, 2025, in Sacramento, CA mason **Howard Cole** and tender **Richard King** with **NuWay Masonry** took first-place at the SABL500 California Regional event. Now they will move forward to compete in the [SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500® Championship in Las Vegas, Nevada](#), at the World of Concrete Tradeshow!

Laying 524 bricks in 60 minutes, the duo topped the competition with an impressive 120 brick margin above the second-place competitors. This team's skills and speed won them the "California's Best Bricklayer" award for a total of \$500 in prize money while securing their tickets to Vegas.
