## ICE Rewrites Enforcement Guidance for I-9 Form Violations

All employers should be aware that on March 16, 2026, the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement agency (ICE) updated the [I-9 Inspection Enforcement Guidance fact sheet](#), significantly expanding the list of Form I-9 paperwork violations considered “substantive” rather than “technical” errors. Under prior guidance, many routine mistakes — such as missing dates, incomplete certifications, or certain preparer/translator omissions — were treated as technical or procedural violations that employers could correct within a 10-business-day cure period following an ICE audit. Now, many of those same errors may be considered “substantive” meaning they **cannot be corrected without penalty**. This means potentially higher fines and penalty totals. Internally auditing your Form I-9s, standardized onboarding procedures, and HR training can help reduce potential exposure in the event of an audit.

### New Substantive Violations include:

- Missing employee date of birth
- Missing date of hire
- Failure to provide date next to employee signature in Section 1
- Missing rehire date
- Missing name and title of the employer representative
- Failure to ensure that the preparer and/or translator’s complete name, address, signature, and date are provided on Form I-9 at the time of completion in Supplement A
