### Essential Worker Verification Card

To assist your personnel in minimizing potential conflict with police and health officials, it is advisable to provide your essential workers (ref. pg. 11 of [California's Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers](#)) with a certification card to display, if confronted about being out in public or working. California users may wish to cut and paste from the [downloadable form](#), shown below, complete the blanks, and print for personnel to carry with them. The form is drafted for use in California, and Contractors in other locations with shelter-in-place orders and exceptions may wish to work with their counsel to prepare similar forms.
