Arbitration Fee Delay Waives

Company's Right To Arbitrate

A recent California court of appeal decision is a stark reminder of the need for employers and their counsel to "pay attention" and promptly pay arbitration fees or risk waiving the hard earned right to arbitrate.

Unsuspecting employers reacting to arbitration fee sticker shock may be inclined to "slow walk" the upfront payment obligations. However, an unknown law makes even an unintentional delay in the payment of fees subject to waiver of the right to arbitrate, which could derail a well-executed legal strategy to avoid a jury trial.

California's Minimum Salary Threshold for Overtime Exemption Increases January 1, 2024

California's minimum wage will increase from \$15.50 per hour in 2023 to \$16 per hour effective January 1, 2024. While a minimum wage increase may not be big news for most in the construction sector, it is noteworthy for its impact to salaried employees' exemption threshold.

 As of January 1, 2024, employees in California must earn an annual salary of no less than \$66,560 to meet one part of the overtime exemption requirement. (An employee must earn no less than two times the state's minimum wage for full-time work to meet this initial requirement of the exemption test.)

Employers be advised:

- Some cities and counties in California have a local minimum wage that is higher than the state rate.
- Employers must post the Minimum Wage Order and the Wage Order applicable to their workplace at a worksite area accessible to employees. Free poster download here.
- Employers must ensure that the wage rate is displayed on the employee's pay stub.

Advanced Clean Fleets Regulation Webinar October 18, 2023 9am - 12pm





The California Air Resources Board (CARB) staff invite you to participate in the first of several public online training webinars on the new Advanced Clean Fleets (ACF) regulation.

This free online training is open to the public and will provide an overview of the ACF regulation, cover who is affected, and outline the upcoming compliance requirements.

About Advanced Clean Fleets (ACF)

The ACF regulation applies to fleets performing drayage operations, those owned by State, local, and federal government agencies, and high priority fleets. High priority fleets are entities that own, operate, or direct at least one vehicle in California, and that have either \$50 million or more in gross annual revenues, or that own, operate, or have common ownership or control of a total of 50 or more vehicles (excluding light-duty package delivery vehicles). The regulation affects medium- and heavy-duty on-road vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8,500 pounds, off-road yard tractors, and light-duty mail and package delivery vehicles.
